MAUI WILDFIRE RECOVERY: THE 'OHANA HOPE VILLAGE







INTRODUCTION

In August 2023, we quickly delivered 160 CN20 units within 9 days of the tragedy through air, land, and sea, in collaboration with local partners, NGOs, the Hungarian Government, and NATO, to offer a sustainable rehousing solution for those affected by the deadliest US wildfire in a century.

THE CONCEPT

- A dignified living environment for 350 disaster survivors
- Arrived on-site with shelters 9 days after the fires
- ▶ 100% off-grid operation
- Rent-free housing
- ▶ 100% privately funded

LONG TERM IMPACT

- ▶ OHV in Lahaina (relocating the homes closer to the disaster area)
- ▶ OHV for the pre-fire homeless community
- OHV as pre-positioned stock for future emergencies
- Establishing a new standard for temporary housing

THE CONCEPT

KEY DESIGN FEATURES OF OHV ON MAUI INCLUDE:

- Quick and efficient installation
- Prioritized comfort and safety
- Modular design for families of various sizes (multigenerational)
- Preservation of traditional Hawaiian lifestyle with shared dining and common spaces
- ▶ 100% renewable solar energy
- Playgrounds, community spaces, and gardens for residents
